ARDS AND NORTH DOWN BOROUGH COUNCIL – PROPOSED PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENT OBJECTIVES 2024/25

The Local Government Act (NI) 2014 Part 12 sets out a General Duty of Improvement in that "a council must make arrangements to secure continuous improvement in the exercise of its functions" having regard, in particular, to: strategic effectiveness; service quality; service availability; fairness; sustainability; efficiency; and innovation. The legislation also sets out that a council must set itself, and work to achieve, 'improvement objectives' relating to the areas outlined above and to publish an Improvement Plan which sets out its plan for discharging its duties for the financial year ahead.

Recognising the need to focus our efforts, on the right things and to demonstrate our commitment to improving the areas that matter most to our residents, we are seeking the views of our residents, statutory partners and other interested parties on our proposed Improvement Objectives 2024/25.
